The Hurricane Watch net has been activated on:

<u>14.325.00 MHz and 7.268.00 MHz.</u> Please avoid transmitting on these frequencies. However, it is fine to listen in.

How to listen to a hurricane watch repeater in Florida.

If you have a Yaesu Fusion radio, you can listen to one of the Florida repeaters running a hurricane net by going to the 443.750 Fusion repeater located on the east side of Indy. It is linked to the southern Indiana room which, in turn, is linked to the Florida repeater.

You can hear the Florida repeater, but the receive side of their repeater will not hear what you transmit. It is responding only to what it hears locally. While listening, you will probably hear local people in Indy and southern Indiana talking from time to time, but they try to be quiet when net control on the Florida repeater talks.

Before you X-Mit Digital -

CAUTION: - Be Aware...

The Hortonville Repeater can only do ONE thing at a Time! Either Analog (FM) or Digital. It Cannot do both at the same time...! If your radio is already in digital only mode, **you may not hear a QSO in progress.**

So, always start in FM first. - Make sure *repeater is not in use* before you switch to digital. **AND - Give your call sign in FM** before you go digital on the repeater.

Piglet Annual Golf Outing - Details.....

Saturday - October 5 - 10am to Noon

The time has come to reveal the details of the 2024 Piglet Golf Open Radio Contest. This event will take place at Prather Park in Carmel at 10:00 AM on Saturday, October 5th and last until 11:30 or 12:00.

The goal of the event will be to make 18 QSOs by calling an open CQ. These 18 QSOs will equate to one hole of a golf round and will be used to determine the score of your round. Depending on the QTH state or country of the responding station, you may score a birdie(3), par(4), bogey(5), or double bogey (6). For non-Canadian DX, it is also possible to score an eagle (2). The scores for each state are listed on your scorecard and greater distances will earn lower scores. The value for each state was determined by the distance from Indiana as determined non-scientifically by me so don't overthink it. There will be a prize for the winner (lowest score).

There are also fun bonus opportunities listed on the scorecard which result in stroke deductions from your final score. If you intend to take part in the event, I'd recommend looking at these ahead of time and making a plan to achieve the maximum bonus. Additional rules may be communicated on-site. Early formation of teams and/or discussion of tactics (publicly or privately) is acceptable.

Bonuses (One stroke deductions unless noted)

- **Club selection** Use three different antenna types (clubs) during the activation (ex. vertical, dipole, and magloop)
- Caddie assistance Utilize the assistance of a non-licensed or inactive individual
- Bunker shot Make all contacts using 10w or less (QRP)
- **2024 Grand Slam** Three of your 18 contacts came from the states hosting the 2024 major American golf tournaments (GA, KY, and NC)
- Just tap it in Each member of the team attempts an actual golf putt. If one team member makes the putt, earn a one-stroke deduction. Players may instead opt to attempt a blindfolded putt for a two-stroke deduction
- Dad's antique clubs Make all contacts with a non-SDR transceiver

• Grandpa's antique clubs - Make all contacts with tube-based equipment (two-stoke deduction) You do not need your own radio equipment or have an amateur radio license to participate. We will be paired with someone that has everything you need.
