DXpedition of note

Rotuma Island: 3D22 and 3D2V Sept 25-Oct 23 (3-4 weeks)

Rotuma Island in the South Pacific island is a province of Fiji. The island is only 9 miles long & 2 miles wide and has a population of around 1600 people. In the 1800s, Rotuma was a popular stop for whaling ships needing to re-provision, and it also became a haven for runaway sailors.

Although it has beautiful beaches and weather, there is no tourism. Rotumans have successfully preserved their culture and customs by preventing foreigners from owning land and prohibiting formal tourism. There are no hotels on the island; any visitors must seek an invitation to stay with a family in their home.

This expedition is being run by the Rebel DX Group and will primarily focus on FT8 contacts. Three operators will be on the island, assisted by remote operators via Starlink. They will have up to 10 radios operating at once with two frequencies per band when possible.

Primarily FT8; also on CW and SSB. 10, 12, 15, 17, 20m: Super Fox & Multistream MSHV modes 30, 40, 60, 80, 160m: Multistream MSHV mode only

Should be 80-100% chance of propagation on FT8, so try em whenever you are on the air. 10-40 meters look to be best, it's a bit of a long haul for 80/160 meters.
