- John Gooldy, W9KD, stated that the Hortonville repeaters are now working much better since the repairs. The Hortonville VHF repeater currently does not have a controller attached to it; so there is only a minimal response from the repeater. This will be fixed in the future. This summer the Hortonville repeaters will be moved to a new location near Atlanta that is further North where a new tower is being installed. Both Noblesville repeaters have lost their network connection due to changes that the county has made. This caused the IP addresses to not be recognized, and we lost our internet capabilities. The county has assigned us to another network, and this has fixed the problem.
