The next course to become a volunteer with our Community Emergency Response Team is starting in September!

Participants will gain hands-on experience in a wide range of emergency skills, including fire safety, basic disaster medical care, disaster preparedness, team organization, traffic and crowd management, home utility shutoff, radio communications, triage, and more. Guided by CERT's motto, "Be the help until help arrives", our program equips individuals to support friends, family, neighbors, coworkers, and the broader community until first responders reach the scene and to assist during large incidents when emergency services may be overwhelmed.

Although the training focuses on disaster readiness and coordinated team response, the skills taught are valuable in everyday situations as well, from rolling up on a car accident to assisting during a medical emergency or other unexpected incidents.

Other Items of Interest**VHF/UHF Band Openings****This Time of Year:**

Primarily due to *weather* (**Temperature Inversions**)

Per John (W9KD),

Early in the morning you might happen to catch a band opening and be able to talk simplex with another ham in a different city (and often a different state). You might also hear a distant repeater and if you can look up the PL tone (knowing the city and the Frequency you are listening to) you can talk to other hams on that distant repeater.

This typically only happens in the mornings and it can be a bit of fun. So, be sure to listen early in the day during the hot summer months. Extreme power and/or extreme antennas are not required. 20 Watts and a reasonable antenna will likely do the trick.
